OPENING UP CHURCH AGAIN

PHASE 1: RETURN

A. Individual Safety

Maintain Safe Distancing

- Masks (Suggested)
- Sanitizer Stations
- No Handshakes
- No Nursery or Children's Church
- No Sunday School
- No Fellowship Time
- No Passing of the Offering Plate (Givelfy, mail in, or give to elders)
- Communion Stations Only (Prepackaged)
- Ushers to enforce safe seating
- Sick MUST stay home
- Regular, frequent, and intense cleaning of high touchpoint areas

B. Church Programming

- Limit services to approximately 60 people (maybe two services will be needed)
- All other church events cancelled
- Continue social media connections
- Continue live-stream for 'vulnerable'

PHASE 2: TRANSITION

A. Individual Safety

Modify to moderate Safe Distancing

- Masks (Optional)
- Sanitizer Stations
- Fist bumps
- No Nursery but resume Children's Church
- Sunday School resumes (for those comfortable—Zoom for others?)
- Resume Fellowship Time
- Resume Passing of the Offering Plate (Maintain Givelfy, mail in, or give to elders)
- Communion Stations Only (prepackaged)
- Ushers to enforce safe seating
- Sick MUST stay home
- Regular, frequent, and intense cleaning of high touchpoint areas

B. Church Programming

- One Service
- Small gatherings resume
- Continue social media connections
- Continue live-stream for 'cautious'

PHASE 3: NEW NORMAL

A. Individual Safety

REMOVE Safe Distancing

- No Masks
- Maintain Sanitizer Stations
- Handshakes
- Resume Nursery & Children's Church
- Sunday School for all
- Resume Fellowship Time
- Resume Passing of the Offering Plate (Maintain Givelfy)
- Normal Communion (prepackaged)
- Normal seating
- Sick MUST stay home (Common Sense)
- Resume Normal cleaning practices

Our Alliance *international workers* (IWs) and their *national partners* have been *servicing* as the *hands* and *feet* of *Jesus* during the COVID-19 *crisis*. Though COVID-19 *changed* the way they do *ministry*, our *IWs* continue to *lean in* and *care* for their *communities*. Here are two *snapshots* of what is *happening* across the *globe* and some *suggestions* on how to *pray*.

CARING IN ONE CREATIVE ACCESS COUNTRY

Although COVID-19 has been *slow* in *arriving* in this *country*, the *economy* is already *suffering* greatly with *closed* borders. *People* there are *struggling* to make *ends* meet *during* what is locally called “*heavy conditions*.”

Many families are *looking* for *hope* under the *weight* of these *heavy conditions*, and our *IWs* there are *sharing* what they have. *Working* with three *local* Alliance *fellowships*, our *IWs* recently *distributed* a *one-month’s* supply of *food* and *soap* to 100 *families* in their area.

Pray that the *families* who *received* the *supplies* will be *transformed* as they *experience* firsthand the *generosity* of *Christ*. Also, *pray* for this creative access *nation* and *region*, asking *God* to preserve *lives* as both the *virus* and *poverty spreads* in the months to come.

CARING IN INDONESIA

Cases of COVID-19 are *spreading* through this *archipelago*. Although little *testing* is being done and *information* is *unclear*, reports of *climbing* death *rates* are emerging in large *urban* areas. Government *lockdowns* are now in *place*, but, *sadly*, they are *having* a *devastating* economic *impact* upon *populations* already on the *edge* of poverty.

In response to the *chaos*, Alliance *IWs* are *remaining* on station and *working* hard to *distribute* bars of *soap* and cloth *masks* across this nation. Also, our *IWs* have been *leading* the *charge* in Alliance *churches* and in *local communities* to teach the *value* of *handwashing* and social *distancing*. Other *IWs* have *adapted* to the challenges of *teaching* Bible *classes* online, giving *public lectures* via Zoom, and *mentoring* by cell phone.

Pray for those who are *unwell* and for our *IWs* as they *strive* to keep their *eyes* on the *goal* of giving *Gospel* access to all people, even during a pandemic—*especially during a pandemic*.

OFFERING ENVELOPE DESIGNATIONS

General Fund – All income that is not designated otherwise goes to our general fund to pay for all the ongoing needs of our ministry – salaries, utilities, insurance, Sunday School, AWANA, AYF, district expense, upkeep, etc. *General Fund

Missions – All giving (whether or not you made a “Faith Promise”) marked “missions” or “**Great Commission Fund**” goes to the National Office to fund the worldwide sharing of the Gospel. *Great Commission Fund

Building Fund – Special improvements. * Building Fund

Extension – These monies are for planting new churches in our Western PA district where a Bible preaching church is needed. *included in Other Missions

Pastoral Support – Any funds received for this category will be moved to General Fund

Benevolent Fund – This is used to minister to those who approach us for help with special needs in times of financial crises. *included in Other Missions

CAMA – The CMA’s world wide famine relief. CAMA stands for Compassion and Mercy Associates and has 30 relief and development workers serving in eight countries. *included in Other Missions

Other Missions – This is used to help other ministries not mentioned above such as – Crossroads, Food Bank, Gideons, Alliance Women, Tim Claybaugh, Grosseohme’s, Murphy’s, Hatcher’s, Eichelman’s & Envision..etc. To give please write the name on the giving envelop.
