



UPDATED NEWS: WORSHIP SERVICES and COVID-19

We have some exciting news. We are going to move into our *Pandemic Return Plan – Phase 1: Return. Today, we continue looking at snapshots of what U.S. Alliance international workers (IWs) are doing in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic.

----Envision: Caring in Manila----

The disruption caused by COVID-19 and the extreme mitigating efforts used in the Philippines to curb its spread have been devastating to Manila's economy and have had a disproportionate impact on the poor. All construction, transportation, and street-side vending jobs have been shut down—the bulk of employment for Manila's poor. This means that the people our IWs serve cannot work, so they cannot eat!

Envision workers assigned to Alliance churches in Manila have been using whatever means they can to pray with and give encouragement to church members, as well as their families and neighbors. They also give practical help when they can. Recently, with the assistance of local churches, they distributed canned meat and rice to 2,000 of Manila's urban poor.


During the coming week, please pray that God would enable these Envision workers to continuing be the hands, feet, and heralds of Jesus and His love! Ask God to bless the ministry of these workers and make them instruments of His of peace and hope for the most vulnerable communities.

----West Africa: Caring for the Destitute----

The disruption caused by COVID-19 and the efforts to stop the spread of that diseases are having a devastating impact on the West African economies. And, just as in the Philippines, those who are affected the most are the poor.

Our IWs serving in West Africa are offering practical help, encouragement, and hope to the destitute in this part of the continent, especially to widows and prison inmates. Food, soap, and cloth masks are being distributed; recently, over 3000 people in one location alone received these supplies. Also, the Alliance Christian radio station in this region is broadcasting educational classes for students whose schools have been closed, while it continues broadcasting the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Please pray that the distribution of food, soap, and face masks and the radio broadcasts will be a witness and a blessing to the mostly unreached people of West Africa.
