# Caring in Chaos

Today, we conclude our focus on what our Alliance international workers (IWs) are doing worldwide in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic by considering one key location.

#### Caring in Cambodía: One Team's Experience

It is amazing how God works! One of the visions He gave to our Alliance workers serving in Cambodia is to promote the growth of house churches and other small groups as vehicles for spreading the Gospel, encouraging and equipping believers for service, identifying and developing leaders, and adding value to the communities in which they live.

**Several** months before the coronavirus began demanding attention, the C&MA churches in Cambodia launched a media team, anticipating that the team would utilize the Internet to help support these house churches and small groups as they appeared. Then, COVID-19 arrived, followed quickly by efforts to restrict the spread of the disease. But, praise the Lord! The Alliance media team was operational and prepared.

An Alliance video in the Cambodian language promptly was released, sharing information about the virus, how to prevent its spread, and how people can find hope and purpose through Christ in the midst of this crisis. Within two weeks, that video had more than 10,000 "views."

**Then,** after the government banned all public meetings and local churches were closed, the media team began posting weekly sermons by Alliance missionaries and pastors and encouraging messages from the president of the Cambodian C&MA. These posts are being viewed by church families in their homes while hosting small gatherings of their believing and non-believing neighbors.

**During** the coming week, please pray that God would bless these small gatherings and use them to bring a revival of discipleship among the Christians in Cambodia. Pray for them to be bold in sharing the Gospel with their families and neighbors and for them to hold tightly to meeting together as the Body of Christ while still observing to safety protocols.
