PHASE 1: RETURN

A. Individual Safety

Maintain Safe Distancing

- No Passing of the Offering Plate (Givelify, mail in, or give to elders)

The Colombian Alliance Family

For nearly a century, Christian & Missionary Alliance international workers and Colombian pastors and churches have been working to advance the Gospel. Praise God! This has resulted in the establishment of The Alliance in 380 locations, with 90,000 members and 150 supporting organizations and compassion ministries.

An important initiative for The Alliance family in Colombia is its effort to meet the needs of disadvantaged Colombians and Venezuelan refugees in the cities of Armenia, Bogotá, and Ipiales. The ministries conducted in these three cities—ministries supported by local Alliance churches and CAMA—serve more than 55,000 people who live in poverty. Here is small sampling of those ministries in one city.

Armenia: Meeting the Needs of Families

The family needs of disadvantaged Colombians and Venezuelan refugees living in Armenia are many and diverse. Consequently, the ministries of local Alliance churches in that city are wide-ranging. For example:


- Locating adequate housing and providing practical supplies such as food, clothing, and housewares
- Running clinics that provide both short- and long-term care for people needing medical attention
- Hosting monthly outreaches where haircuts, meals, legal assistance, and eye exams are provided
- Launching "Health Brigands," which are small ministry teams that teach family health care
- Advising small business owners on better business practices
- Offering counseling and rudimentary training for those seeking employment

Ministries such as these are avenues through which needy people experience genuine love, are introduced to Jesus Christ, and enter into the discipleship process.

During the coming week, thank God for the success of Alliance churches across Colombia, thanking Him in particular for the work of our churches in the city of Armenia. Also, ask for God's continued blessing upon the entire Alliance family as it proceeds to advance the Gospel in this South American country using its unique, Christ-centered ministries.
