Prayer Focus for the Month





One Key Initiative of the Alliance: Meeting the needs of poverty-stricken people living the cities of Armenia, Bogotá, and Ipiales

Strategy: Using unique, Christ-centered ministries, Alliance international workers are partnering with local pastors and their churches to demonstrate genuine love to needy people, to introduce them to Jesus Christ, and to help them enter into the discipleship process.

An Example: One recent ministry conducted by one Alliance church in the capital city of of Colombia

La Alianza Betel Church—Feeding Refugees in Bogotá

Ministry Focus: Venezuelan refugees living in the church's neighborhood

Tactics:

- Serving lunches on Tuesdays and Thursdays to those in need of a good meal
- · Holding a short period of devotions during each meal
- Church members visiting with, listening to, and encouraging their guests

Impact:

- 50-60 meals are served every Tuesday and Thursday.
- As of March 1, more than 1,500 meals had been served to about 200 persons.
- As of March 1, fifteen refugees were attending the church and others were attending fellowships closer to their homes.
- Native-born Colombians attending this church have learned to see refugees with eyes of love and mercy and have rallied around these folks who are considered to be intruders by so many other Colombians.
- Venezuelan refugees are experiencing the love of Jesus Christ and hearing the Good News.

OFFERING ENVELOPE DESIGNATIONS

<u>General Fund</u> – All income that is not designated otherwise goes to our general fund to pay for all the ongoing needs of our ministry – salaries, utilities, insurance, Sunday School, AWANA, AYF, district expense, upkeep, etc. *General Fund

<u>Missions</u> – All giving (whether or not you made a "Faith Promise") marked "missions" or "Great Commission Fund" goes to the National Office to fund the worldwide sharing of the Gospel. *Great Commission Fund

Building Fund - Special improvements. * Building Fund

<u>Extension</u> – These monies are for planting new churches in our Western PA district where a Bible preaching church is needed. *included in Other Missions

Pastoral Support – Any funds received for this category are moved to General Fund

<u>Benevolent Fund</u> – This is used to minister to those who approach us for help with special needs in times of financial crises. *included in Other Missions

<u>CAMA</u> – The CMA's world wide famine relief. CAMA stands for Compassion and Mercy Associates and has 30 relief and development workers serving in eight countries. *included in Other Missions

<u>Other Missions</u> – This is used to help other ministries not mentioned above such as – Crossroads, Food Bank, Gideons, Alliance Women, Tim Claybaugh, Grossoehme's, Murphy's, Hatcher's, Eichelman's & Envision..etc. To give please write the name on the giving envelop.
