The Colombian Alliance Family

In our last two bulletin inserts, we learned about two of the new ministries utilized by Alliance churches in Colombia to reach some of the most

needy in this South American country. Here's another brief example of the exciting work being done on behalf of the Kingdom of God.

The Ipiales Alliance Church—Sheltering the Displaced

Ipiales is a city close to the Ecuadorian border in Colombia, and because of its location, it has become an essential point of entry for Venezuelans fleeing the humanitarian crisis in their home country. Approximately 3,000 of these migrants arrive daily, and after walking for nearly 50 days, they enter Ipiales exhausted, hungry, and without prospects.

In an effort to help meet the immediate needs of some these Venezuelans, the The Ipiales Alliance Church opened a shelter to care for 50 people in January 2020. In this safe haven, the refugees receive food, shelter, Biblical counseling, legal counsel, and a basic medical examine.

Interestingly, the shelter was to open in 2019, but the legal process required to finalize the project was interrupted. Rather than wait for the the legal process to resume, church families began taking refugees into their homes, allowing them to rest, feeding them, and offering whatever support they could. By "seizing the moment," Alliance church families demonstrated the compassion of Jesus Christ to those whose futures were uncertain.

Thank God the Father for utilizing The Ipiales Alliance Church to bless and introduce a needy, displaced people to the love of Jesus Christ. And, ask Him to continue inspiring and equipping this Alliance ministry, and others like it across Colombia, to demonstrate and testify to the grace of our Savior.


