

Alliance international workers (IWs) entered Colombia in 1923 and quickly planted a small church in the city of Ipiales. Since that time, The Alliance has blossomed into a vibrant movement with 380 locations, 90,000 members, and an effective national organization.

The Colombian Christian and Missionary Alliance now is considered to be a self-supporting and self-propagating movement. Therefore, Alliance IWs from the U.S. have existed this country. However, there is one area in which U.S. support remains.

Through the generosity of U.S. Alliance churches, the humanitarian wing of The Alliance, Compassion and Mercy Associates provides organizational and financial assistance to those local Colombian churches that help alleviate the suffering of disadvantaged Colombians and Venezuelan refugees living in their neighborhoods. Thus, the most needy are introduced to the compassion of Jesus Christ.



During the coming week, let us thank God for using the Alliance in Colombia and for allowing the Alliance family to flourish. Also, ask Him to continue blessing The Colombian C & M A as it carries on its mission to preach, baptize, and disciple in the name of Jesus Christ while modeling God's instructions to Israel:

"If among you, one of your brothers should become poor, in any of your towns within your land that the LORD your God is giving you, you shall not harden your heart or shut your hand against your poor brother, but you shall open your hand to him and lend him sufficient for his need, whatever it may be." (Deuteronomy 15:7-8)

"When a stranger sojourns with you in your land, you shall not do him wrong. You shall treat the stranger who sojourns with you as the native among you, and you shall love him as yourself, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God." (Leviticus 19:33-34)
