



Prayer Focus for the Month

Gabon--officially the Gabonese Republic--is located on the west coast of central Africa, bordering that section of the Atlantic Ocean

known as the Gulf of Guinea. Its size is more than twice than that of Pennsylvania at 103,346 square miles. Its population, however, is only about sixteen percent of Pennsylvania's at approximately 2.1 million people.

Christian and Missionary Alliance international workers (IWs) from the United States first entered this equatorial country in 1934. Since that time, the Alliance has established 115 churches, all of which have been officially recognized by the Gabonese government and are able to support their own pastors and leaders. As the largest family of evangelical churches in Gabon, these churches are taking the initiative to plant new churches and reach into new areas of their homeland with the Gospel.

Today, all U. S. church-planting and related IWs have transitioned from Gabon, and the national church is working toward becoming a complete church-planting and missionary- sending partner in the worldwide Alliance movement. The only remaining U.S. Alliance workers serving in Gabon are connected with Bongolo Hospital located in the town of Lebamba in southwestern Gabon, where people hear Jesus' message of hope in their darkest hours.

Thank God for the way He has used and blessed The Christian and Missionary Alliance Church of Gabon, and ask Him to continue using the national church to enlarge His influence by spreading the Gospel among the Gabonese people.
