# Prayer Focus for the Coming Week

**Operation World,** a prayer guide for international missions, calls Gabon a spiritual battlefield, citing a number of challenges faced by those advancing the Gospel:



- Seventy percent of Gabon's population identifies itself as Christian, but this is misleading.
  - Many of those who make this claim simply have integrated Christian beliefs with their native, pagan beliefs that often include perverse cultic practices. This is especially true of the interior regions of Gabon.
  - Some traditional churches have been penetrated by liberal theologies, especially by the prosperity theologies that appeal to those who live in poverty.
  - Others, though well-intentioned, have disintegrated into mere social justice movements.
- 2. Gabon is experiencing an increase in Islamic conversions, especially among men.
  - Since the conversion Gabon's president to Islam in 1973, this
    movement receives political support from the Gabonese
    government.
  - An influx of Muslim immigrants also have contributed to the religion's growth.
- 3. Although Gabon seems affluent compared to its neighbors, poverty is a fact of life for most people in this country. One of the most impactful results of this poverty is that alcoholism is endemic.

**But, praise God!** The evangelical Church is still **present** in Gabon, **preaching** the Gospel of Jesus Christ and and **demonstrating** His love. And, praise God, again! The **C** & **M A Church of Gabon** is leading the way. Knowing this and keeping in mind the challenges faced by the **evangelical Church at large**, let us **unite in prayer** on behalf of **Gabon** during this coming week:

- Ask God's Spirit to revive all parts of the Church and make it again a force for evangelism.
- Pray for the Church to rightly discern between true and false teachings.
- Pray for the evangelization of the deep, interior regions of this nation.
- Pray for those who struggle daily with poverty, asking for them to find relief from this burden. Also, ask that the Church be instrumental in meeting their needs.
