

Paraguay is a landlocked country in the south-central heartland of South America. Slightly smaller than the state of California, it is a beautiful country that holds a population of over 7 million, culturally diverse people.



The Alliance began its ministry in Paraguay in 1965 when an Argentine pastor/missionary planted a church in Asunción, the nation's capital and largest city. That church remained the only Alliance community in Paraguay for thirty-five years until three other churches were planted in 2000. Today, there are seven Paraguayan Alliances churches. Working with these seven churches is a multicultural team that includes international workers from the United States, Chile, Argentina, Trinidad, and the Philippines.

The C & M A international workers serving in Paraguay focus their attention upon three initiatives:

- 1. planting and developing self-supporting, missionary-sending churches in the Asunción and Ciudad del Este metropolitan areas;
- 2. encouraging the Paraguayan national church to plant its own churches and to send its own pastors/missionaries into the unevangelized western and eastern regions of Paraguay; and
- **3.** identifying and training local leaders to serve as pastors/missionaries who are instilled with C & M A doctrine/ownership.



During the coming week, let us prayerfully uphold the Alliance movement in Paraguay, asking God:

- to utilize its ministries to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ among all Paraguayan people; and
- to send more Alliance international workers to serve in Paraguay, where an increasing number of people are becoming open to the Gospel.
