Missions Prayer Focus for August



The vast majority of Paraguayans claim to be adherents of Christianity. Sadly, a closer look undermines that claim.

- Ninety percent of the population is Roman Catholic, and Catholicism has had a long-lasting, positive impact on this country.
- Today, however, most people who identify themselves as Catholics have merged this tradition with elements of native religions, which has resulted in something that is neither Catholic nor Christian. For that matter, it isn't even pagan.

Praise the Lord! Among the remaining 10% who are adherents of Christianity, there are evangelical believers.

- · However, the percentage of evangelical believers is unclear.
- Observers of missions in Paraguay differ on the percentage of evangelicals in Paraguay's population, their estimates ranging from 3.1% to 8.1%.
- Nevertheless, these same experts agree that the number of true believers is growing—yes, slowly—but growing.

During the coming week, let us intercede for the spiritual welfare of Paraguay.

- Pray for the Spirit of Truth to renew the Church and break the power of superstition.
- Pray for the Spirit of Truth to sweep though this country and bring about a great spiritual awakening among its people.
- Pray that the Spirit of Truth would use the Alliance as a channel for this revival and for this great awakening.
