Paraguay

Missions Prayer Focus for the Coming Week

Observers of Paraguay maintain that this South American country suffers from decades of authoritarianism that institutionalized corruption and favoritism.

Over the years, this abuse and misuse of power by government officials has been a major impediment to the development of this country. Although recent democratic and economic reforms have been instituted, corruption and favoritism continue to negatively impact this country.

- High levels of poverty, inequality, and the inaccessibility of potable water, health care, education, and sanitation are major issues, especially among indigenous people in rural areas.
- Bribery, money-laundering, counterfeiting, drug trafficking, smuggling, and fundraising for extremist groups go unchecked, especially along the Argentina-Brazil-Paraguay borders. Local officials are often complicit in these crimes.
- Crimes against women and children also are considered major problems. Laws are in place to prevent or punish these crimes, but those laws are largely unenforced.

During the coming week, please pray that:

- *the Alliance family in Paraguay will be a model of righteousness among its neighbors and would be a source of compassion, hope, and community development through Christ-centered ministries;*
- *government leaders will embrace God's righteousness in place of corruption and concern themselves with the general welfare of their countrymen.*
