Fireside Room - Mike and Beth Long

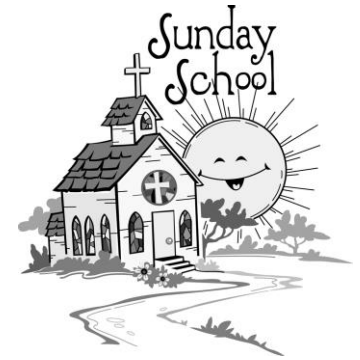
The curriculum covers Books of the Bible - studying Old Testament one quarter then moving to the New Testament in the next. This quarter the study is Romans. All adults are welcomed.

Prayer Focus for the Week
CAMA
Compassion and Mercy Associates

In 1972, the Alliance established *Compassion and Mercy Associates (CAMA)* to meet the overwhelming *needs* of refugees fleeing Vietnam, Cambodia, and Laos. *Today*, as a *specialized structure* of *Alliance Missions*, CAMA responds globally to the *needs* of people affected by *violence, poverty, and disasters*. Working in *partnership* with local *leaders*, local *believers*, and the local *church*, CAMA focuses on *taking* the *Gospel* to *people* who find themselves in their most *desperate* and *vulnerable* moments.

One important facet of CAMA's work is *managing* twenty-eight, long-term *community development projects* in *sixty-two* countries that provide:

- *assistance in developing micro-enterprises and agricultural improvements;*
- *literacy and vocational training;*
- *language studies;*
- *medical care and health education;*
- *sports programs; and*
- *occupational therapy for the disabled.*

CAMA also *responds* to *natural* and *man-made disasters*. During these disasters, *CAMA* cooperates with *local churches* to:

- *distribute food, water, clothing, and other basic necessities;*
- *create safe havens for those who are in immediate danger;*
- *assist displaced persons in finding housing; and*
- *provide funds for medical care and for counseling.*

Through these and other types of *faithful witness*, CAMA workers *demonstrate God's love* to *needy people* and develop *compassionate relationships* through which the *Gospel* can be *shared*.

During the coming week, let us thank God for CAMA's wide-ranging ministries and the opportunities they afford. Also, pray that God will continue blessing and enlarging the work of this Alliance organization.
