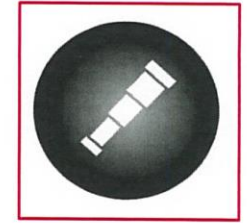

Prayer Focus for the Week

Envision



Envision is a **ministry** of the Christian and Missionary **Alliance** consisting of **seventy** full-time workers serving in **twenty** urban areas in the **United States** and around the **world**. The **purpose** of this **ministry** is to **advance** the **Kingdom** of God by **demonstrating** the **love** of God through **community development** projects. To accomplish this purpose, *Envision workers* seek **partnerships** with **local churches** through which they **establish** and **strengthen** new **communities of faith** among the **unreached** in **metropolitan areas**.

Envision workers operate a number of **ministries** that **vary** from **urban area** to urban area, **depending** upon the **needs** of each population to whom they minister. Usually, there are **four** to **eight** ministry **projects** at each *Envision* site. And, each **ministry** is used as an **avenue** for building **relationships** with **individuals** through which **needs** can be met, **conversations** can occur, **connections** among **strangers** can be built, the **love** of **God** is **demonstrated**, **lives** are **changed**, people discover **Christ**, and **communities of faith** are **developed**.

There seems to be a common **concern** among full-time *Envision workers*. There are an **insufficient** number of short-term and long-term **volunteers** from **local churches** to meet the **demands** for them in all areas of **ministry**. With that in mind, let us **address** this general **need** through **prayer** this coming week.

Ask the **Lord** of the harvest to **move** among **local churches** in the twenty *Envision* urban locations and **call** forth short-term and long-term **workers** to **serve** in these **ministries**.

Pray that they will **serve faithfully**, joining God as He advances His Kingdom, and that they **grow spiritually** as they **help other** people find **Christ**.
