Your love and support of us showed up on day 1.

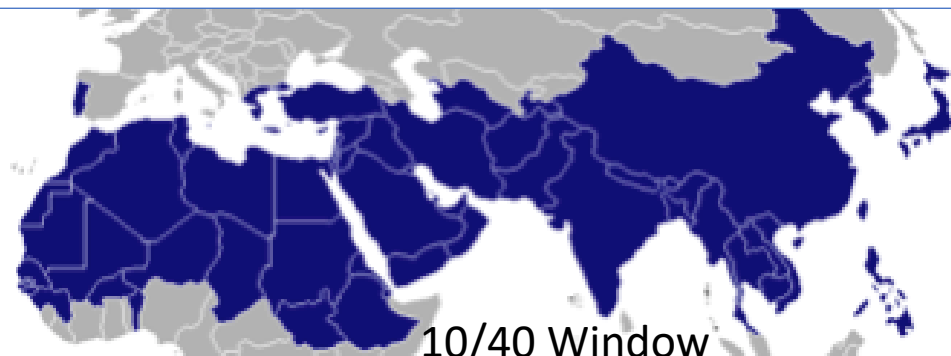
Here is just a sampling of things we are so grateful for:

10/40 Window

In many of the 69 nations, witnessing the Christian Gospel is illegal and will result in imprisonment or death.

45 of the 50 worst countries in the world for persecution of Christians are in the 10/40 Window.

A majority of the world's terrorist organizations are based in the 10/40 Window, and children as young as 18 months old are trained to be Jihad soldiers.

National missionaries, i.e., native citizens, have the best opportunities to reach out to others as the hands and feet of Jesus. However, even national missionaries and pastors are not exempt from persecution.

Pray

*Protection, strength, and unity for local believers to persevere despite persecution.

*Bind the powers in the heavenly realms that are opposed to these peoples discovering the light of the Lord Jesus Christ and His salvation.

2Th. 3:1- 3 Finally, brethren, pray for us that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as *it did* also with you; and that we will be rescued from perverse and evil men; for not all have faith. But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.
