#### **OFFERING ENVELOPE DESIGNATIONS**

<u>General Fund</u> – All income that is not designated otherwise goes to our general fund to pay for all the ongoing needs of our ministry – salaries, utilities, insurance, Sunday School, AWANA, AYF, district expense, upkeep, etc. \*General Fund

<u>Missions</u> – All giving (whether or not you made a "Faith Promise") marked "missions" or "Great Commission Fund" goes to the National Office to fund the worldwide sharing of the Gospel. \*Great Commission Fund

Building Fund - Special improvements. \* Building Fund

<u>Extension</u> – These monies are for planting new churches in our Western PA district where a Bible preaching church is needed. **\*included in Other Missions** 

Pastoral Support - Any funds received for this category will be moved to General Fund

<u>Benevolent Fund</u> – This is used to minister to those who approach us for help with special needs in times of financial crises. **\*included in Other Missions** 

<u>CAMA</u> – The CMA's world wide famine relief. CAMA stands for Compassion and Mercy Associates and has 30 relief and development workers serving in eight countries. \*included in Other Missions

## **NOVEMBER PRAYER FOCUS - HONDURAS**





About 95% of the population claim Christianity, and Roman Catholicism is the largest segment. There are several CMA churches in Honduras. One flooded during the hurricanes.

Because of COVID and the hurricanes; many more people are begging on the streets and food is being stolen from people as they leave supermarkets.

Up to 80% of Hondurans have lost their jobs, many have gone hungry and most children's education has suffered greatly due to lack of internet access or stationery.

The long term problems facing the Church are socioeconomic issues, such as children at risk, HIV/AIDS, and gang violence. More than half of the population are children, and the streets are full of orphans and unwanted children who get pulled into the gang or sex trade lifestyle out of desperation.

Pray for our sister churches as they respond to those in financial and spiritual need. Give them the wisdom to know how best to affect the lives of their people.

Pray that the Church and other ministries will reach out to these desperate children and that God would use His people to comfort those hurting across Honduras.
