January Prayer Focus - India



Hindu extremists believe that all Indians should be Hindus, and that the country should be rid of Christianity. They use extensive violence particularly targeting Christians from a Hindu background. Christians are blamed for bad luck in their communities. These believers are often physically attacked and sometimes killed. Many believers are

isolated and don't know any other Christians.

Persecution in India has increased significantly over the past five years, and has now remained relatively unchanged for the past year. The COVID-19 pandemic has offered a new weapon for persecutors. Christians are often deliberately overlooked when official COVID-19 food and aid are distributed. This has left many desperate for food, particularly since many Christians are from the Dalit caste and thus very poor, and have lost their sources of income this year.

Pray for protection for our brothers and sisters, especially those who are new Christians, and those who live in rural areas and are particularly isolated. Pray God will help their families and communities to accept their new faith.
