## **January Prayer Focus - India**



On December 8, 2020, Pastor Salim Stephen Surin, a part-time evangelist in Rania village of Jharkhand's West Singhbhum district, was killed in the east Indian state of Jharkhand while he was returning home with his wife after baptizing five new believers. His wife abandoned their motorbike and took a ten hour walk home through thick brush and forest to avoid the attackers.

We attempted to contact an Indian CMA congregation on Facebook but got no response. They have not posted since summer and face the same persecution as this evangelist.

This is the prayer request from another missionary organization:

Praise God that many are coming to faith in India through miraculous healings and the courageous witness of India's Christians. Pray this will continue, and many more will come to know Jesus.

Pray for protection for our brothers and sisters, especially those who are new Christians, and those who live in rural areas. Pray God will help their families and communities accept their new faith.

Ask God to continue to work through and encourage the partnership of local workers and missionaries. Pray for wisdom and energy and ask God to protect them as they carry out this vital work, particularly during the pandemic.
