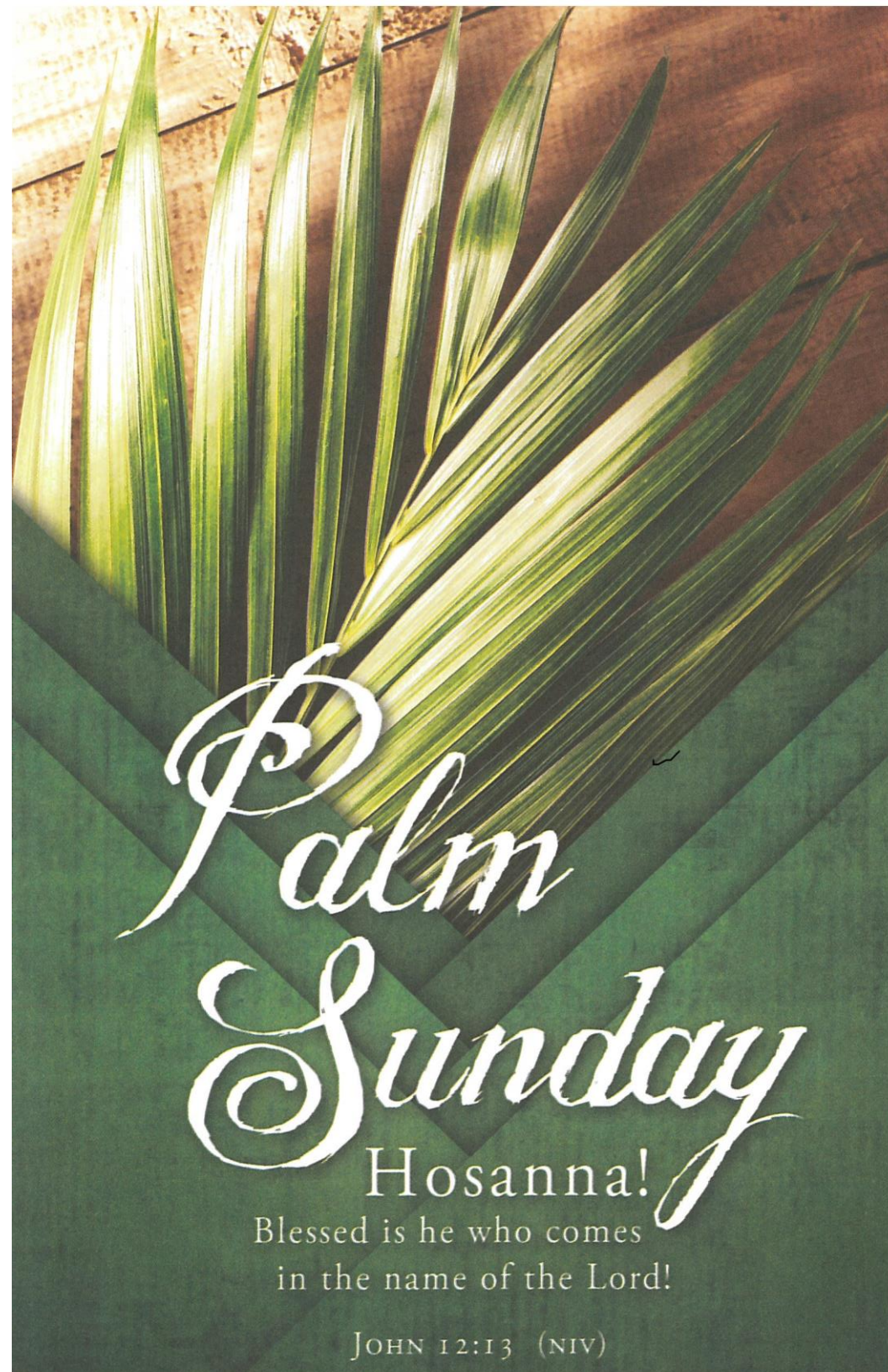

Immersion Trips

Immersion trips are great opportunities for churches to experience a cross-cultural context, learn about majority world religions, eat unique food and experience the work of God among the unreached people of NYC. We host 1-3 day immersion teams depending on how much exposure and experience you would like.

Volunteer

There are a variety of ways you can volunteer. Whether you want to volunteer every week, every month or from home a few states away there are many creative ways that you can join in!

Internships

We're excited to have you serve alongside us in NYC. Through hands-on ministry (like teaching English, building relationships, and serving in daily cross-cultural encounters) you will be developed as you learn to lead in ministry. Internships can be from 1 month to 11 months.

Residency

An Envision Residency is designed to provide an opportunity for hands-on ministry experience in a cross-cultural setting while preparing them for long-term service. This two-year program is cohort-based, intentionally aimed to develop ministry readiness, discipleship values, cross-cultural agility, leadership, and spiritual depth.
