

May Prayer Focus – Germany

Several couples are working to establish a Spanish speaking church in Berlin. Over the past years, the Spanish economy sent Spanish speakers, from Spain and those who had relocated to Spain from Latin American countries, to Germany to find work and more stability. There are an estimated 30,000 Spanish Speakers in Berlin alone. In January 2017 they joined together and began the church plant, Vida Abundante of the MAKD (German CMA). In the first year, they saw over 16 people come to faith in Jesus in miraculous ways. They held their first baptismal service later that summer and saw 4 people baptized. From there, they have continued to see people come to Christ and be baptized over the past 4 years.

They are in the process of training leaders from within the church, a process that has taken some time, as they continue to grow both numerically and in spiritual depth as a church. It is their goal to hand over church leadership while beginning another church plant.

It is their desire to see those who God has relocated in Berlin to come to faith in Jesus Christ. They assume that if they encounter Spanish Speakers, that God has brought them there to meet Him. In the next years, they hope to plant several more churches and also have a more firmly established church-based seminary in coordination with the German National CMA Church (ABI—Alliance Bible Institute) for the purpose of training and raising up national leadership. One fun fact is that though they are part of the German CMA, the quickly growing majority is among immigrants (Chinese, Arabic, and Spanish speakers). The MAKD (German CMA) is very international.

Continue to pray for growth of these immigrant churches.
