The violence of extremism is rampant and has become a dangerous part of everyday life for many. Palestinian Christians, who trace their roots back to Pre-Islamic times, face pressures from both Islamists and Israelis, enduring constant persecution. Arab evangelicals face isolation and rejection from Arabs, Jews, and even many Christians worldwide. The loss of leadership to continuing emigration remains a hindrance in the growth and expansion of the Church. The hope for a true peace and a solution over the land often seems bleak. May God bring peace in the land, and may both Jew and Arab alike meet the Prince of Peace. Through Him alone will any meaningful reconciliation occur.

Pray for God's purposes to be fulfilled in these areas:

- A just settlement of the land issue, and the future of both the Jewish settlements in Palestine and the Palestinians in Israel itself. Both sides feel strong claims to the land. Both Israelis and Palestinians claim Jerusalem as their exclusive capital.
- Improved living conditions. Estimates suggest that 70% of Gaza live in deep poverty, and 80% depend on external aid. Only 28% of Gaza have regular access to clean water. Debate over the causes and the fault does not change the fact that there is much suffering.
- A legitimate and effective leadership to govern Palestine. Political groups Fatah and the PLO (Palestinian Liberation Organization) both have low approval ratings, but somehow retain power and influence. Together with the sometimes heavy-handed treatment by Israel, this leaves many open to recruitment by radical and violent Islamic groups. Pray for every Palestinian family to hear and see the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Pray not only for the peace of Jerusalem, but also that both sides meet the Prince of Peace. It is through Him alone that any meaningful reconciliation will come.

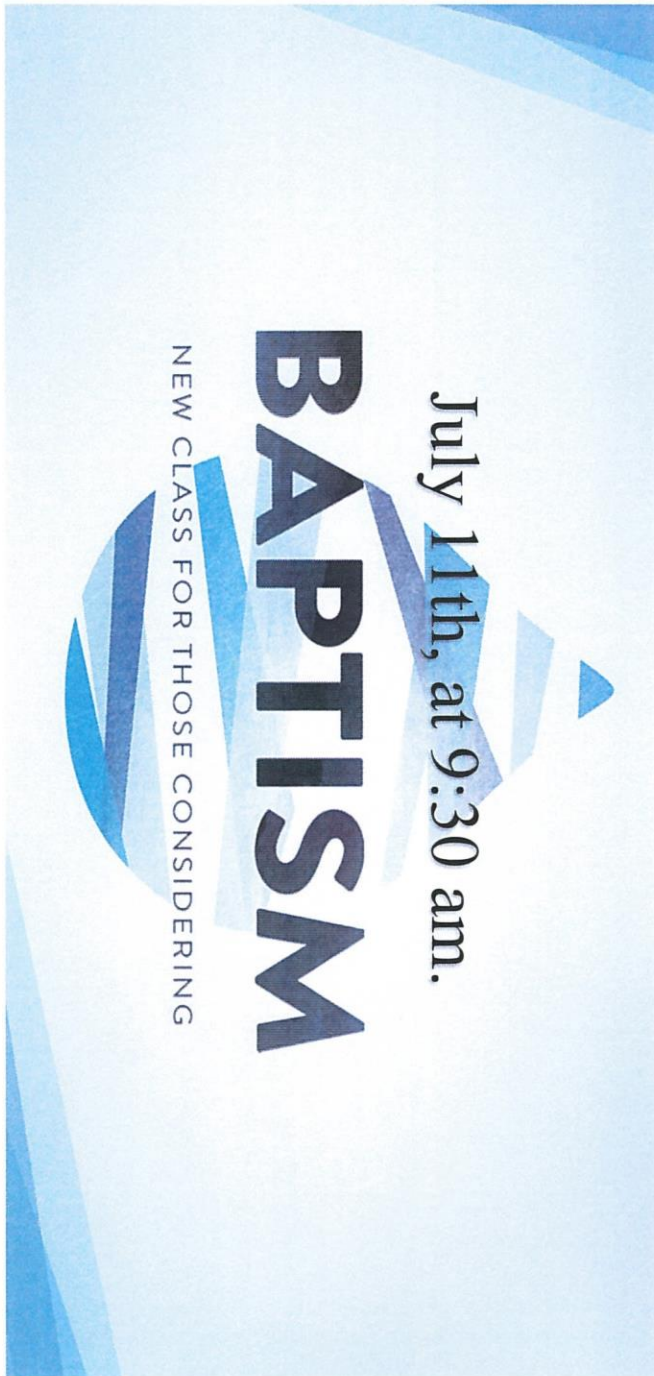
