



August Prayer Focus 10/40 Window -Mauritania



A brief review of Mauritania. It is technically open for proselytizing, however Islam is to official state religion. Since there is strong persecution it is unsafe to share the gospel openly. If we have workers in this country they will be creative access workers.

As the last nation in the world to abolish slavery in 1981, an estimated 10-20 percent of the population still lives in bondage, a fact the Mauritanian government vehemently denies.

Mauritania is an Islamic Republic and the Mauritanian constitution states that Islam is the religion of the people and the state. Ninetynine percent of the population is Muslim; Mauritanians believe they are the most Islamic state on the continent and that their mission is to spread Islam throughout black Africa.

There are only a handful of Christians among this entire people and have been persecuted and ostracized by both their families and tribes. We see a new day of growth and witness among the Saharawi through low-key mission work and national believers. There are openings for ministry to refugees through relief and development, and difficult political and living conditions lead to considerable openness.

- Pray for the Word of God to be preached among Mauritanians in their heart language.
- Pray for God's mercy in the wake of severe drought and a poor economy.
- Pray for Christ's freedom to be understood by those in bondage of slavery to man and to false religions.
