Father, Your workers in creative-access locations greatly extol You, for You stand at the right hand of the needy and save their lives from those who would condemn them. Let more peoples in these areas turn their ears to Your wisdom so they will find knowledge of You, for from Your mouth comes understanding. Establish Your workers in righteousness so tyranny will be far from them and they will have nothing to fear (Psalm 109:30–31; Proverbs 2:2, 5–6; Isaiah 54:14).

Praise the Lord that several families have finally been able to return from the United States to their ministry locations! “We’re grateful for safe travels, negative COVID test results, and a chance to get settled in and ready for ministry,” the team writes. Pray for these families as they get reacclimated to life in their host cities, as children start school again, and as ministries are begun or resumed.

Two people are on a short-term missions trip in a creative-access location. Pray that they will learn much about the culture and that lives will be changed for God’s Kingdom.

A Missions Festival for youth and young adults was held August 17–21. Ask the Lord to speak to the hearts of young people whom He is calling to serve Him on the mission field.

Three recent high school graduates are beginning their first year of college. Pray for them and their families as they are far apart and for many blessings to flow into the lives of these young people.

New converts are experiencing persecution from their family and relatives. Pray that the believers will stand firm in their faith, especially those who are college students and newly baptized members.

In one creative-access location, more than 1,000 people have taken their lives during COVID-19 lockdowns. Many businesses have gone bankrupt, jobs have been lost, and people are in despair because of the failing economy. Pray for a team that is providing relief and sharing Jesus’ love with those in need.
