September Prayer Focus – West Africa



More than 200 pastors' kids are gathered for camp last month. The theme was forgiveness and standing firm in the faith. Pray that lives will change for participants of this event.

Several widows have been neglected by their families. Pray for patience amid this hardship and that others will step up to help with their needs.

“We praise the Lord for the many opportunities that our short-term team had to share the gospel with women and young women,” an Alliance team writes. More than 400 attended a girls' camp. “Pray that the ministry of our visiting team will have lasting impact on all participants.”

An Alliance team ministers at a Christian school for the deaf; pray for them as they prepare for the new school year. Pray also that parents will bring their deaf children and that the Lord will provide all that is needed for the school to function successfully.

It's malaria season in a West African country where Alliance workers serve in a hospital ministry. “Children are on the floors, in the hallway, and sometimes two to one bed,” they report. Pray that this team will know how to encourage the hospital staff and the chaplain amid these difficult conditions.

An Alliance team writes, “We are thankful for a smooth transition to new leadership in our national church.” Pray for those newly elected, as well as for vision and wisdom as the Alliance church network faces many challenges.
